Finding early success with her debut single "Speak Out" in 2020, Gamble achieved remarkable milestones. Her influence further expanded as she graced a Times Square Billboard and captivated readers with a compelling four-page feature in the 2021 Amazon Bestseller, 'Women of Inspiration, Women Driving Change.' Furthermore, she made history as the youngest artist ever to be showcased on HOLR Magazine's renowned 'In The Mirror' podcast in 2021.

Gamble has been captivating audiences with her profound voice and musical charisma since she was nine years old. She has already performed for thousands of people, sharing the stage with acclaimed artists such as JUNO/CCMA Award winner Brett Kissel, Neon Dreams, Lenka, and Stacey Kay. Notably, Gamble has headlined Hayley Wickenheiser's WickFest for four consecutive years, solidifying her status as a captivating performer. In 2022 & 2023, she made history as the youngest artist chosen to grace the stage at Canadian Music Week in Toronto.

Deeply committed to philanthropy, Gamble frequently lends her talent to support numerous charitable causes. Her unwavering dedication to charitable endeavors earned her the prestigious Women of Inspiration Youth Excellence award in 2019, making her the first Canadian recipient of this esteemed recognition, acknowledging her outstanding contributions to both music and philanthropy.
