Soulful pop artist from Calgary, Alberta, Kaiya Gamble has musical prowess that transcends her young age. Notably recognized as a contestant on American Idol Season 22, the singer, songwriter, and multi-instrumentalist weaves together captivating melodies and heartfelt lyrics that resonate deeply with listeners, creating a powerful connection that transcends boundaries.

Finding early success with her debut single "Speak Out" in 2020, Gamble achieved remarkable milestones. The song soared to the Top 3 in the 2021 International Women's Freedom Song Contest, received airplay on Alberta's premier radio stations, and earned a nomination for Pop Single of the Year at the 2021 YYC Music Awards. Additionally, she garnered recognition as the Standout Artist in Lawson Vocal Studio's esteemed national 'Becoming' contest in 2021. Her influence further expanded as she graced a Times Square Billboard and captivated readers with a compelling four-page feature in the 2021 Amazon Bestseller, 'Women of Inspiration, Women Driving Change.'

Gamble has been captivating audiences since she was just nine years old. She has already performed for thousands of people, sharing the stage with acclaimed artists such as JUNO/CCMA Award winner Brett Kissel, and Lenka. In 2022 & 2023, she made history as the youngest artist chosen to perform at Canadian Music Week (CMW) in Toronto.

Deeply committed to philanthropy, Gamble frequently lends her talents to support various charitable causes. Her dedication to making a positive impact earned her the prestigious Women of Inspiration Youth Excellence award in 2019, making her the first Canadian recipient of this esteemed recognition.
